And Peter said, Man, I am not. ⁵⁹ And about the space of one hour after another confidently affirmed, saying, Of a truth this fellow also was with him: for he is a Galilaean. ⁶⁰ And Peter said, Man, I know not what thou sayest. This means that in time of peace, prepare for war. Because when you fail to prepare, then you prepare to fail.

No matter what happens to you, don't compromise your faith. Don't allow your problems to make you decide to warm yourself in the fire of the enemy. Don't go to the enemy to receive help. Every help received from the enemy would be paid back with interest because satan has no free gift. God is the only free giver.

WHAT IS ADVERSITY?

The meaning of "adversity" is something turning against you.

- Adversity is a state of hardship or affliction. It is a state which is contrary to our well being.
- Adversity means misfortune, distress and, sometimes, tragedy or poverty.
- Adversities are circumstances that cause trouble and sorrow.
- Adversities can be disasters, opposition or trouble.
- Adversity can be trials, unfavorable circumstances, and hostile opposition

Matthew 4:1-4 (KJV)

² And when he had fasted forty days and forty nights, he was afterward an hungred. ³ And when the tempter came to him, he said, If thou be the Son of God, command that these stones be made bread. ⁴ But he answered and said, It is written, Man shall not live by bread alone, but by every word that proceedeth out of the mouth of God.
