

AT JESUS' FEET

JESUS REVEALED THE TRUTH CONCERNING THE MYSTERY OF GOD THROUGH THE FOLLOWING SCRIPTURES

Matthew 13:1-3, 10-17 (KJV)

¹ The same day went Jesus out of the house, and sat by the sea side. ² And great multitudes were gathered together unto him, so that he went into a ship, and sat; and the whole multitude stood on the shore. ³ And he spake many things unto them in parables
¹⁰ And the disciples came, and said unto him, Why speakest thou unto them in parables? ¹¹ He answered and said unto them, *Because it is given unto you to know the mysteries of the kingdom of heaven, but to them it is not given.* ¹² For whosoever hath, to him shall be given, and he shall have more abundance: but whosoever hath not, from him shall be taken away even that he hath. ¹³ Therefore speak I to them in parables: because they seeing see not; and hearing they hear not, neither do they understand. ¹⁴ And in them is fulfilled the prophecy of Esaias, which saith, By hearing ye shall hear, and shall not understand; and seeing ye shall see, and shall not perceive: ¹⁵ For this people's heart is waxed gross, and their ears are dull of hearing, and their eyes they have closed; lest at any time they should see with their eyes, and hear with their ears, and should understand with their heart, and should be converted, and I should heal them. ¹⁶ But blessed are your eyes, for they see: and your ears, for they hear. ¹⁷ For verily I say unto you, That many prophets and righteous men have desired to see those things which ye see, and have not seen them; and to hear those things which ye hear, and have not heard them.

From these Scriptures, Jesus said that the mysteries of the kingdom of heaven were not given to be understood by unbelievers, but only by believers. Even, among the believers, the new revelation that is unrevealed in the Old Testament can only be understood by those believers who are willing to hear and understand.

IN 1 CORINTHIANS 2:6-3:3, APOSTLE PAUL DESCRIBES FOUR CATEGORIES OF PEOPLE IN RELATION TO THE NEW TESTAMENT MYSTERIES.

1. THE FIRST CATEGORY IS THE NATURAL MAN, WHO IS THE UNSAVED MAN

1 Corinthians 2:7-8 (KJV)

⁷ But we speak the wisdom of God in a mystery, even the hidden wisdom, which God ordained before the world unto our glory: ⁸ Which none of the princes of this world knew: for had they known it, they would not have crucified the Lord of glory.

2. THE SECOND CATEGORY IS THE BABE IN JESUS

1 Corinthians 3:1-2 (KJV)

¹ And I, brethren, could not speak unto you as unto spiritual, but as unto carnal, even as unto babes in Christ. ² I have fed you with milk, and not with meat: for hitherto ye were not able to bear it, neither yet now are ye able.

The babe is the new believer who, for now, can only understand the “milk” of the Word of God. Therefore, he is not yet ready to understand the mysteries because they are only given to the believer that desires the “meat” of the Word of God

3. THE THIRD CATEGORY IS THE CARNAL MAN

1 Corinthians 3:3 (KJV)

³ *For ye are yet carnal: for whereas there is among you envying, and strife, and divisions, are ye not carnal, and walk as men?*

The carnal man is the believer who has been saved long enough to progress from milk to meat, but he is not matured and still drinking the milk of the Word of God. He has the ability to understand, but will not understand because of immaturity and lack of desire and motivation. This is the type of believer who fills his spiritual needs through worldly things and experiences.

4. THE FOURTH CATEGORY IS THE SPIRITUAL MAN

1 Corinthians 2:10-13, 15-16 (KJV)

¹¹ *For what man knoweth the things of a man, save the spirit of man which is in him? even so **the things of God knoweth no man, but the Spirit of God.*** ¹² *Now we have received, not the spirit of the world, but **the spirit which is of God;** that we might know the things that are freely given to us of God.*

¹³ *Which things also we speak, not **in the words** which man's wisdom teacheth, but **which the Holy Ghost teacheth; comparing spiritual things with spiritual.***

¹⁵ *But **he that is spiritual** judgeth all things, yet he himself is judged of no man.* ¹⁶ *For who hath known the mind of the Lord, that he may instruct him? **But we have the mind of Christ.***

The spiritual man is the believer who has disciplined himself to study the Word of God, and is instructed by the Holy Spirit. He understands the deep things and the mysteries of God.

IT IS THEREFORE ESSENTIAL FOR ONE TO SIT AT THE FEET OF JESUS TO BE THOUGHT AND IMPACTED WITH THE WORD OF LIFE.

Luke 10:38-42 (KJV)

³⁸ *Now it came to pass, as they went, that he entered into a certain village: and a certain woman named Martha received him into her house. ³⁹ And she had a sister called Mary, which also sat at Jesus' feet, and heard his word. ⁴⁰ But Martha was cumbered about much serving, and came to him, and said, Lord, dost thou not care that my sister hath left me to serve alone? bid her therefore that she help me. ⁴¹ And Jesus answered and said unto her, **Martha, Martha, thou art careful and troubled about many things: ⁴² But one thing is needful: and Mary hath chosen that good part, which shall not be taken away from her.***

THERE IS RESURRECTION BY BEING USED TO SIT AT JESUS' FEET

John 11:32 (KJV)

³² *Then when Mary was come where Jesus was, and saw him, **she fell down at his feet, saying unto him, Lord, if thou hadst been here, my brother had not died.***

When you are used to sit at Jesus' feet, every dead thing in your life shall be resurrected in Jesus name.

THE SICK ARE MADE WHOLE AT JESUS' FEET

Matthew 15:29-31 (KJV)

²⁹ *And Jesus departed from thence, and came nigh unto the sea of Galilee; and went up into a mountain, and sat down there. ³⁰ And great multitudes came unto him, having with them those that were lame, blind, dumb, maimed, and many others, and **cast them down at Jesus' feet; and he healed them:** ³¹ *Insomuch that the multitude wondered, when they saw the dumb to speak, the maimed to be whole, the lame to walk, and the blind to see: and they glorified the God of Israel.**

If you can only come and sit at Jesus' feet, every impotency in your life shall be healed in the name of Jesus.

THE CAPTIVES ARE SET FREE AT JESUS' FEET

Mark 7:25-30 (KJV)

²⁵ For a certain woman, whose young daughter had an unclean spirit, heard of him, and came and fell at his feet: ²⁶ The woman was a Greek, a Syrophenician by nation; and she besought him that he would cast forth the devil out of her daughter. ²⁷ But Jesus said unto her, *Let the children first be filled: for it is not meet to take the children's bread, and to cast it unto the dogs.* ²⁸ And she answered and said unto him, Yes, Lord: yet the dogs under the table eat of the children's crumbs. ²⁹ And he said unto her, *For this saying go thy way; the devil is gone out of thy daughter.* ³⁰ And when she was come to her house, she found the devil gone out, and her daughter laid upon the bed.

If you can only run to Jesus' feet, then every captivity and satanic assault against your life shall be broken in the name of Jesus.

Desire the meat of the word of God to sit at the feet of Jesus to fulfill all God's plans for your live in the name of Jesus.
