Ephesians 1:5 (KJV)

⁵ *Having predestinated us unto the adoption of children by Jesus Christ to himself, **according to the good pleasure of his will,***

God works two things in us to will and to do of his good pleasure

Philippians 2:13 (KJV)

¹³ *For it is God which worketh in you both **to will and to do of his good pleasure.***

Psalms 35:27 (KJV)

²⁷ *Let the LORD be magnified, which **hath pleasure in the prosperity of his servant.***

1. KEEP THE WORD OF GOD

Deuteronomy 29:9 (KJV)

⁹ *Keep therefore the **words of this covenant, and do them,** that ye may **prosper in all that ye do.***

Joshua 1:8 (KJV) – the Word of God will prosper you.

⁸ *This book of the law shall not depart out of thy mouth; but thou shalt meditate therein day and night, that thou mayest observe to do according to all that is written therein: **for then thou shalt make thy way prosperous, and then thou shalt have good success.***

Isaiah 55:11 (KJV)

¹¹ *So shall my word be that goeth forth out of my mouth: it shall not return unto me void, **but it shall accomplish that which I please, and it shall prosper in the thing whereto I sent it.***

Satan’s greatest desire is to keep you in an eternal poverty

Proverbs 20:13 (KJV)

¹³ *Love not sleep, lest thou come to poverty; open thine eyes, and thou shalt be satisfied with bread (Luke 4:4: man shall live by the word of God).*

2 Corinthians 4:3-4 (KJV)

³ *But if our gospel be hid, it is hid to them that are lost:*

⁴ *In whom the god of this world hath blinded the minds of them which believe not, lest the light of the glorious gospel of Christ, who is the image of God, should shine unto them.*

JESUS CAN SET YOU FREE FROM THE CURSE OF POVERTY

John 3:18-19 (KJV)

¹⁸ *He that believeth on him is not condemned: but he that believeth not is condemned already, because he hath not believed in the name of the only begotten Son of God. ¹⁹ And this is the condemnation, that light is come into the world, and men loved darkness rather than light, because their deeds were evil.*

Deceived by the preaching of a false gospel

2 Corinthians 11:13-15 (KJV)

¹³ *For such are false apostles, deceitful workers, transforming themselves into the apostles of Christ.*

¹⁴ *And no marvel; for Satan himself is transformed into an angel of light.*

¹⁵ *Therefore it is no great thing if his ministers also be transformed as the ministers of righteousness; whose end shall be according to their works.*

Break satanic powers over your life and desire to be rich by coming out their evil deception.

I. HOW DO YOU BREAK LOOSE FROM SATAN'S DECEPTION AND LIVE A PROSPEROUS LIFE?

Three types of bad ground and three types of good ground where the word is sown

Mark 4:14-20 (KJV)

¹⁴ *The sower soweth the word.*

- First Bad ground

¹⁵ *And these are they **by the way side**, where the word is sown; but when they have heard, Satan cometh **immediately**, and taketh away the word that was sown in their hearts.*

- Second bad ground

¹⁶ *And these are they likewise which are **sown on stony ground**; who, when they have heard the word, immediately receive it with gladness; ¹⁷ And have no root in themselves, and so endure but for a time: afterward, when affliction or persecution ariseth for the word's sake, immediately they are offended.*

- Third background

¹⁸ *And these are they which are **sown among thorns**; such as hear the word, ¹⁹ And the cares of this world, and the deceitfulness of riches, and the lusts of other things entering in, choke the word, and it becometh unfruitful.*

Good grounds

²⁰ *And these are they which are **sown on good ground**; such as hear the word, and receive it, and bring forth fruit, some thirtyfold, some sixty, and some an hundred.*

First good ground: *some thirtyfold,*

Second good ground: *some sixty, and*

Third good ground: *some an hundred.*

Philippians 2:16 (KJV)

¹⁶ *Holding forth the word of life; that I may rejoice in the day of Christ, that I have not run in vain, neither laboured in vain.*
