HOW TO DEAL WITH DISCOURAGEMENT

Jeremiah 20:7 (KJV)

⁷ O LORD, thou hast deceived me, and I was deceived: thou art stronger than I, and hast prevailed: I am in derision daily, every one mocketh me.

What do you do when your marriage suddenly collapses and the home you have been building for thirty years become scattered?

What do you do when you suffer serious attack from those you assisted?

2 Kings 4:1 (The Message)

 1 4 One day the wife of a man from the guild of prophets called out to Elisha, "Your servant my husband is dead. You well know what a good man he was, devoted to GOD. And now the man to whom he was in debt is on his way to collect by taking my two children as slaves."

A. ALLOW THE LORD TO TAKE CARE OF YOUR SITUATION

Psalm 55:22 (KJV)

²² Cast thy burden upon the LORD, and he shall sustain thee: he shall never suffer the righteous to be moved.

B. SEE THE DIVINE POSSIBILITY IN YOUR SITUATION

Believe that the blessing and the breakthroughs you need lie in divine possibilities. You must live in the consciousness that every problem has an end. Do not live in the consciousness that your affliction and trials will not end. Believe that your trials are over. Miracles begin when you see divine possibilities.

When you know that God can do it again in your life, you realize that your troubles, sickness, financial embarrassment, fear and satanic attack can come to an end. You must begin to see divine possibilities in your situation:

She called out to Elisha - She believed in divine possibilities

2 Kings 4:2-4

² Elisha said, "I wonder how I can be of help. Tell me, what do you have in your house?" "Nothing," she said. "Well, I do have a little oil."

³⁻⁴ "Here's what you do," said Elisha. "Go up and down the street and borrow jugs and bowls from all your neighbors. And not just a few—all you can get. **Then come home and lock the door behind you**, you and your sons. Pour oil into each container; when each is full, set it aside."

c. Believe that all things are possible

Mark 9:23 (KJV)

²³ Jesus said..., If thou canst believe, all things are possible to him that believeth.
