#### He that do the will of God lives forever

#### 1 John 2:16-17 (KJV)

<sup>16</sup> For all that is in the world, the lust of the flesh, and the lust of the eyes, and the pride of life, is not of the Father, but is of the world.

Three things that are not of the God:

- 1. The lust of the flesh
- 2. The lust of the eyes
- 3. The pride of life
