³⁵ I have shewed you all things, how that so labouring ye ought to support the weak, and to **remember the** words of the Lord Jesus, how he said, It is more blessed to give than to receive.

FOUR MAIN TYPES OF GIVING IN THE BIBLE

1. TITHES

Its motivation: Obedience Malachi 3:8-12 (KJV)

How much? 10%

THE TITHES ARE DIVINE CONNECTION TO THE BLESSING

Genesis 14:18-20 (KJV)

¹⁸ And **Melchizedek king of Salem** brought forth bread and wine: and **he was the priest of the most high God**.

¹⁹ **And he blessed him**, and said, Blessed be Abram of the most high God, possessor of heaven and earth: ²⁰ And blessed be the most high God, which hath delivered thine enemies into thy hand. And **he gave him tithes of all**.

2. THE FIRSTFRUITS

Its motivation: Generosity

Exodus 23:19 (KJV)

Proverbs 3:9-10 (KJV)

Ezekiel 44:30 (KJV)

³⁰ And the first of all the firstfruits of all things, and every oblation of all, of every sort of your oblations, shall be the priest's: ye shall also give unto the priest the first of your dough, that he may cause the blessing to rest in thine house.

Firstfruits shows you don't love money- you give it to the church or to the ministry (Pastor) It shows your gratitude to God for extra blessing – it's done once a year for each salary raised.

⁸ Will a man rob God? Yet ye have robbed me. But ye say, Wherein have we robbed thee? In tithes and offerings.

⁹Ye are cursed with a curse: for ye have robbed me, even this whole nation.

¹⁰ Bring ye all the tithes into the storehouse, that there may be meat in mine house, and prove me now herewith, saith the LORD of hosts, if I will not open you the windows of heaven, and pour you out a blessing, that there shall not be room enough to receive it.

And I will rebuke the devourer for your sakes, and he shall not destroy the fruits of your ground; neither shall your vine cast her fruit before the time in the field, saith the LORD of hosts.

¹² And all nations shall call **you blessed**: for ye shall be a delightsome land, saith the LORD of hosts.

¹⁹ The first of the firstfruits of thy land thou shalt bring into the house of the LORD thy God.

⁹ Honour the LORD with thy substance, and with the firstfruits of all thine increase:

¹⁰ So shall thy barns be filled with plenty, and thy presses shall burst out with new wine.

Its motivation: Compassion

Its motivation: Faith and reward
