John 10:10 (KJV)

¹⁰ The thief cometh not, but for to steal, and to kill, and to destroy: I am come that they might have life, and that they might have it more abundantly.

HERE IS OF THE LAWS OF THE SPIRIT OF LIFE IN CHRIST JESUS (ROM 8:2)

Matthew 6:14-15 (KJV)

¹⁴ For if ye forgive men their trespasses, your heavenly Father will also forgive you:

¹⁵ But if ye forgive not men their trespasses, neither will your Father forgive your trespasses.

DON'T JOIN HANDS WITH SATAN TO DESTROY OTHERS

2 Corinthians 2:10-11 (KJV)

¹⁰ To whom ye forgive any thing, I forgive also: for if I forgave any thing, to whom I forgave it, for your sakes forgave I it in the person of Christ; ¹¹ Lest Satan should get an advantage of us: for we are not ignorant of his devices.

When you don't forgive someone, satan takes advantage of you

SATAN TAKES ADVANTAGE OF US BY BLOCKING US FROM RECEIVING FROM GOD

Mark 11:24-26 (KJV)

*²⁴ Therefore I say unto you, **What things soever ye desire, when ye pray, believe that ye receive them, and ye shall have them.** ²⁵ And **when ye stand praying, forgive, if ye have ought against any: that your Father also which is in heaven may forgive you your trespasses.** ²⁶ But if ye do not forgive, neither will your Father which is in heaven forgive your trespasses.*

SATAN WILL TAKE ADVANTAGE OF YOU BY MAKING YOU ONE OF HIS AGENTS THROUGH GOSSIP

Colossians 3:13 (KJV)

¹³ Forbearing one another, and forgiving one another, if any man have a quarrel against any: even as Christ forgave you, so also do ye.

BE CAREFUL ABOUT WHOM YOU LISTEN TO

Galatians 6:1-2 (KJV)

¹ Brethren, if a man be overtaken in a fault, ye which are spiritual, restore such an one in the spirit of meekness; considering thyself, lest thou also be tempted. ² Bear ye one another's burdens, and so fulfil the law of Christ.

SATAN IS THE ACCUSER OF THE BRETHREN

Revelation 12:10-11 (KJV)

*¹⁰ for **the accuser of our brethren** is cast down, which accused them before our God day and night.*

DON'T MAKE GOD A LIAR FOR HE IS NOT A MAN TO LIE

1 John 1:8-10 (KJV)

⁸ If we say that we have no sin, we deceive ourselves, and the truth is not in us. ⁹ If we confess our sins, he is faithful and just to forgive us our sins, and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness.

¹⁰ If we say that we have not sinned, we make him a liar, and his word is not in us.

If we don't forgive others, we are telling God that we have no sin.

TREAT OTHER PEOPLE THE WAY YOU WANT THEM TO TREAT YOU

Matthew 7:12 (KJV)

¹² Therefore all things whatsoever ye would that men should do to you, do ye even so to them: for this is the law and the prophets.

Partiality is the most general sin committed amount the Christian – don't seek your own.

WHAT GOD REQUIRES OF YOU?

Micah 6:8 (KJV)

⁸ He hath shewed thee, O man, what is good; and what doth the LORD require of thee, but to do justly (be fair), and to love mercy, and to walk humbly with thy God?

God wants you to be fair – God is good to you when you are good to others – God is kind to us when we are kind to others

GOD WILL NOT BE MERCIFUL TO YOU IF YOU HAVE NO MERCY TOWARDS OTHERS

James 2:13 (KJV)

¹³ For he shall have judgment without mercy, that hath shewed no mercy;

Psalms 37:25 (KJV)

²⁵ I have been young, and now am old; yet have I not seen the righteous forsaken, nor his seed begging bread.

JESUS WAS TEMPTED, HE DID NOT SIN AND WAS ABLE TO FORGIVE

Hebrews 4:15-16 (KJV)

¹⁵ For we have not an high priest which cannot be touched with the feeling of our infirmities; but was in all points tempted like as we are, yet without sin. ¹⁶ Let us therefore come boldly unto the throne of grace, that we may obtain mercy, and find grace to help in time of need.

WHAT THE LAW COULD NOT DO THE HOLY SPIRIT DOES IT

Romans 8:3-4 (KJV)

³ For what the law could not do, in that it was weak through the flesh, God sending his own Son in the likeness of sinful flesh, and for sin, condemned sin in the flesh: ⁴ That the righteousness of the law might be fulfilled in us, who walk not after the flesh, but after the Spirit.

JOSEPH FORGAVE HIS BROTHERS

Genesis 50:20-21 (KJV)

²⁰ But as for you, ye thought evil against me; but God meant it unto good, to bring to pass, as it is this day, to save much people alive. ²¹ Now therefore fear ye not: I will nourish you, and your little ones. And he comforted them, and spake kindly unto them.

PAUL FORGAVE HIS CO-WORKERS IN THE MINISTRY

2 Timothy 4:14-18 (KJV)

¹⁴ Alexander the coppersmith did me much evil: the Lord reward him according to his works: ¹⁵ Of whom be thou ware also; for he hath greatly withstood our words.

¹⁶ At my first answer no man stood with me, but all men forsook me: I pray God that it may not be laid to their charge. ¹⁷ Notwithstanding the Lord stood with me, and strengthened me; that by me the preaching might be fully known, and that all the Gentiles might hear: and I was delivered out of the mouth of the lion. ¹⁸ And the Lord shall deliver me from every evil work, and will preserve me unto his heavenly kingdom: to whom be glory for ever and ever. Amen.
