⁴⁴ And he that was dead came forth, bound hand and foot with graveclothes: and his face was bound about with a napkin. Jesus saith unto them, *Loose him, and let him go.*

¹⁹ For he hath looked down from the height of his sanctuary; from heaven did the LORD behold the earth; ²⁰ To hear the groaning of the prisoner; to loose those that are appointed to death;

Luke 4:18-19 (KJV) The purpose of the preaching of the gospel

¹⁸ *The Spirit of the Lord is upon me, because he hath anointed me to preach the gospel to the poor; he hath sent me to heal the brokenhearted, to preach deliverance to the captives, and recovering of sight to the blind, to set at liberty them that are bruised,*

¹⁹ *To preach the acceptable year of the Lord.*

WHO IS A CURSED MAN AND WHO IS BLESSED?

Jeremiah 17:5-8 (KJV)

⁵ Thus saith the LORD; Cursed be the man that trusteth in man, and maketh flesh his arm, and whose heart departeth from the LORD.

⁶ For he shall be like the heath in the desert, and shall not see when good cometh; but shall inhabit the parched places in the wilderness, in a salt land and not inhabited.

⁷ Blessed is the man that trusteth in the LORD, and whose hope the LORD is.

⁸ For he shall be as a tree planted by the waters, and that spreadeth out her roots by the river, and shall not see when heat cometh, but her leaf shall be green; and shall not be careful in the year of drought, neither shall cease from yielding fruit.

Psalm 1:1-3 (KJV)

¹ Blessed is the man that walketh not in the counsel of the ungodly, nor standeth in the way of sinners, nor sitteth in the seat of the scornful.

² But his delight is in the law of the LORD; and in his law doth he meditate day and night.

³ And he shall be like a tree planted by the rivers of water, that bringeth forth his fruit in his season; his leaf also shall not wither; and whatsoever he doeth shall prosper.

JESUS REDEEM US FROM THE CURSE

Galatians 3:10-14 (KJV)

¹⁰ For as many as are of the works of the law are under the curse: for it is written, Cursed is every one that continueth not in all things which are written in the book of the law to do them.

¹¹ But that no man is justified by the law in the sight of God, it is evident: for, The just shall live by faith.

¹² And the law is not of faith: but, The man that doeth them shall live in them.

¹³ Christ hath redeemed us from the curse of the law, being made a curse for us: for it is written, Cursed is every one that hangeth on a tree:

¹⁴ That the blessing of Abraham might come on the Gentiles through Jesus Christ; that we might receive the promise of the Spirit through faith.

2 Corinthians 5:21 (KJV)

²¹ *For he hath made him to be sin for us, who knew no sin; that we might be made the righteousness of God in him.*

The more you see how much Jesus loves you the more you see how much he had forgave you. And the more you see how much he had forgave you, the more you love him.

1 John 4:19 (KJV)

¹⁹ *We love him, because he first loved us.*

WHO IS JESUS TO YOU?

John 12:5-8 (KJV)

⁵ *Why was not this ointment sold for three hundred pence, and given to the poor?*

⁶ *This he said, not that he cared for the poor; but because he was a thief, and had the bag, and bare what was put therein.*

⁷ *Then said Jesus, **Let her alone: against the day of my burying hath she kept this.***

⁸ ***For the poor always ye have with you; but me ye have not always.***

Luke 10:41-42 (KJV)

⁴¹ *And Jesus answered and said unto her, **Martha, Martha, thou art careful and troubled about many things:***

⁴² ***But one thing is needful: and Mary hath chosen that good part, which shall not be taken away from her.***

HOW MUCH WE WERE FORGIVING IN THE PAST?

2 Peter 1:9 (KJV)

⁹ *But he that lacketh these things is blind, and cannot see afar off, and hath forgotten that he was purged from his old sins.*

Don't be blind see afar and remember how much Christ has done for you and see the afar future (1000 years from now)

DIFFERENCE BETWEEN ADAM'S SIN AND CAIN'S SIN

Two different types of sins caused two different types curses:

1. Curse of the work on your hand
2. Curse on yourself

Adam's sin caused the work of his hands to be cursed for he hurts himself.

Genesis 3:17 (KJV)

¹⁷ *cursed is the ground for thy sake; in sorrow shalt thou eat of it all the days of thy life;*

But there was a curse on the work on his hands because he blamed his wife. When you keep blaming others, the work of your hands is cursed.

CAIN'S SIN CAUSED HIM TO BE CURSED BECAUSE HE HURT HIS BROTHER

Genesis 4:11-12 (KJV)

¹¹ *And now art thou cursed from the earth, which hath opened her mouth to receive thy brother's blood from thy hand;*

¹² *When thou tillest the ground, it shall not henceforth yield unto thee her strength; a fugitive and a vagabond shalt thou be in the earth.*

When you start gossiping, backbiting, evil speakers, and jalousie toward a brother then there is a curse on you.

Treat others how you want them to treat you.

Luke 6:37 (KJV)

³⁷ *Judge not, and ye shall not be judged: condemn not, and ye shall not be condemned: **forgive, and ye shall be forgiven:***

Matthew 7:12 (KJV)

¹² *Therefore all things whatsoever ye would that men should do to you, do ye even so to them: for this is the law and the prophets.*

ISSUE WITH SICKNESS

John 5:4-6 (KJV) – Sickness caused by sin for thirty eight years

⁵ *And a certain man was there (at the pool of Bethesda), which had an infirmity thirty and eight years.*

⁶ *When Jesus saw him lie, and knew that he had been now a long time in that case, he saith unto him, **Wilt thou be made whole?***

John 5:14 (KJV)

¹⁴ *Afterward Jesus findeth him in the temple, and said unto him, **Behold, thou art made whole: sin no more, lest a worse thing come unto thee.***

Luke 13:11-12 (KJV) – Sickness caused by Satan for eighteen years

¹¹ *And, behold, there was a woman which had a spirit of infirmity eighteen years, and was bowed together, and could in no wise lift up herself.*

¹² *And when Jesus saw her, he called her to him, and said unto her, **Woman, thou art loosed from thine infirmity.***

Luke 13:16 (KJV)

¹⁶ *And ought not this woman, being a daughter of Abraham, **whom Satan hath bound, lo, these eighteen years, be loosed from this bond on the sabbath day?***

John 9:1-3 (KJV)

¹ *And as Jesus passed by, he saw a man which was blind from his birth.*

² *And his disciples asked him, saying, Master, who did sin, this man, or his parents, that he was born blind?*

³ *Jesus answered, **Neither hath this man sinned, nor his parents: but that the works of God should be made manifest in him.***

THROUGH PRAYER AND FASTING YOU WILL BE LOOSED

Psalms 102:17-20 (KJV)

¹⁷ *He will regard the prayer of the destitute, and not despise their prayer.*

¹⁸ *This shall be written for the generation to come: and the people which shall be created shall praise the LORD.*

¹⁹ *For he hath looked down from the height of his sanctuary; from heaven did the LORD behold the earth;*

²⁰ *To hear the groaning of the prisoner; to loose those that are appointed to death;*

Isaiah 58:6 (KJV)

⁶ *Is not this the fast that I have chosen? to loose the bands of wickedness, to undo the heavy burdens, and to let the oppressed go free, and that ye break every yoke?*
