WE STAND ON A BETTER COVENANT

Hebrews 8:13 (KJV)

¹³ *In that he saith, A new covenant, he hath made the first old. Now that which decayeth and waxeth old is ready to vanish away.*

Hebrews 8:6-10 (KJV)

⁶ *But now hath he obtained a more excellent ministry, by how much also he(JESUS) is the mediator of a better covenant, which was established upon better promises.*

⁷ *For if that first covenant had been faultless, then should no place have been sought for the second.*

⁸ *For finding fault with them, he saith, Behold, the days come, saith the Lord, when I will make a new covenant with the house of Israel and with the house of Judah:*

⁹ *Not according to the covenant that I made with their fathers in the day when I took them by the hand to lead them out of the land of Egypt; because they continued not in my covenant, and I regarded them not, saith the Lord.*

¹⁰ *For this is the covenant that I will make with the house of Israel after those days, saith the Lord;*

JESUS THE MEDIATOR OF THE NEW COVENANT

Jesus Saved us from Sin

Matthew 1:21 (KJV)

²¹ *And she shall bring forth a son, and thou shalt call his name JESUS: for he shall save his people from their sins.*

Jesus means savior, He came to save us from sin.

John 1:17 (KJV)

¹⁷ For the law was given by Moses, but grace and truth came by Jesus Christ.

Romans 6:14 (KJV)

¹⁴ For sin shall not have dominion over you: for ye are not under the law, but under grace.

Romans 8:1-3 (KJV)

² For the law of the Spirit of life in Christ Jesus hath made me free from the law of sin and death.

³ For what the law could not do, in that it was weak through the flesh, God sending his own Son in the likeness of sinful flesh, and for sin, condemned sin in the flesh:

- We are not under Moses (Law) but under Jesus Christ (Grace – Romans 8:2)
- Grace is superior to law – what law could not do, grace did it.

WHAT IS SAVE FROM SIN? — WHAT IS YOUR DEFINITION OF SIN?

Our definition of sin depends of our view of sin.

If we talk about the Ten Commandments, most of us must simply says that we are righteous because we don't commit those types of sins, therefore we must not need Jesus at all or we must say that we are already saved.

Romans 7:5-6 (KJV)

⁵ For when we were in the flesh, the motions of sins, which were by the law, did work in our members to bring forth fruit unto death.

⁶ But now we are delivered from the law, that being dead wherein we were held; that we should serve in newness of spirit, and not in the oldness of the letter.

But when we read the gospel, we find that Jesus spoke about other sins which are not listed in the Ten Commandments at all. Jesus spoke about **sin in the heart. Sin is of the Heart.**

Psalm 119:11 (KJV)

¹¹ Thy word have I hid in mine heart, that I might not sin against thee.

GOD'S WAY IS DIFFERENT FROM MAN'S WAY — LIVE ONLY UNTO THE GLORY OF THE LORD

Isaiah 55:6-7 (KJV)

⁶ Seek ye the LORD while he may be found, call ye upon him while he is near:

⁷ Let the wicked forsake his way, and the unrighteous man his thoughts: and let him return unto the LORD, and he will have mercy upon him; and to our God, for he will abundantly pardon.

JESUS WILL NOT STOP YOU FROM GOING TO HELL IF YOU WANT TO

Revelation 22:11-15 (KJV)

¹¹ He that is unjust, let him be unjust still: and he which is filthy, let him be filthy still: and he that is righteous, let him be righteous still: and he that is holy, let him be holy still.

¹² And, behold, I come quickly; and my reward is with me, to give every man according as his work shall be.

¹³ I am Alpha and Omega, the beginning and the end, the first and the last.

¹⁴ Blessed are they that do his commandments, that they may have right to the tree of life, and may enter in through the gates into the city.

¹⁵ For without are dogs, and sorcerers, and whoremongers, and murderers, and idolaters, and whosoever loveth and maketh a lie.

Numbers 23:21 (KJV)

²¹ He hath not beheld iniquity in Jacob, neither hath he seen perverseness in Israel: the LORD his God is with him, and the shout of a king is among them.

WALK IN NEWNESS OF LIFE

Romans 6:4 (KJV)

⁴ Therefore we are buried with him by baptism into death: that like as Christ was raised up from the dead by the glory of the Father, even so we also should walk in newness of life.

There are sins Jesus spoke about, that God considers to be serious but man don't really consider to be very serious.

1 John 4:19-20 (KJV)

¹⁹ We love him, because he first loved us. ²⁰ If a man say, I love God, and hateth his brother, he is a liar: for he that loveth not his brother whom he hath seen, how can he love God whom he hath not seen?

HYPOCRISY —PRETENSE, LIE ARE THE SAME SIN

Mark 8:15 (KJV)

¹⁵ And he charged them, saying, *Take heed, beware of the leaven of the Pharisees, and of the leaven of Herod.*

Definition of leaven: it is a substance (as yeast) used to produce fermentation in dough or a liquid

THE LEAVEN OF THE PHARISEES

Luke 12:1-3 (KJV)

¹ In the mean time, when there were gathered together an innumerable multitude of people, insomuch that they trode one upon another, he began to say unto his disciples first of all, **Beware ye of the leaven of the Pharisees, which is hypocrisy.** ² For there is nothing covered, that shall not be revealed; neither hid, that shall not be known. ³ Therefore whatsoever ye have spoken in darkness shall be heard in the light; and that which ye have spoken in the ear in closets shall be proclaimed upon the housetops.

1 Corinthians 5:6-8 (KJV)

⁶ Your glorying is not good. Know ye not that a little leaven leaveneth the whole lump?

⁷ Purge out therefore the old leaven, that ye may be a new lump, as ye are unleavened. For even Christ our passover is sacrificed for us: ⁸ Therefore let us keep the feast, not with old leaven, neither with the leaven of malice and wickedness; but with the unleavened bread of sincerity and truth.
